

JOINT STATEMENT

The Endangered Wildlife Trust and Rhino Force (Afrika Force) hereby announce that they have agreed to settle the dispute between them by signing a settlement agreement on the 7th December 2012.

As such The Endangered Wildlife Trust and Rhino Force (Afrika Force) have terminated their original agreement and the Endangered Wildlife Trust and Rhino Force (Afrika Force) will henceforth continue to pursue their own respective initiatives.

Rhino Force (Afrika Force) assures the public that the Endangered Wildlife Trust will receive the full amount of the agreed donations due from the sale of all Rhino Force bracelets bearing the Endangered Wildlife Trust logo and / or name, as well as all other donations made in the name of rhino conservation, as is stipulated in the settlement agreement.

The Endangered Wildlife Trust assures the public that all monies already donated, and those yet to be donated, to the Endangered Wildlife Trust from the sale of the Rhino Force Bracelets bearing the Endangered Wildlife Trust logo have been, and will be, directly and fully allocated to Rhino anti-poaching activities.

Rhino Force (Afrika Force) and the Endangered Wildlife Trust take this opportunity to thank the public, the retail entities and the corporations who have generously supported the Rhino Force Bracelet initiative.
